PROGRAM DELETION JUSTIFICATION
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

1. Why is the program being deleted?

The Court Reporting Technology degree is being deleted due to low enrollment. During the past 5 ½ years, enrollment in the degree program declined to 24 students making the Court Reporting program non-viable despite efforts to promote the programs and class schedules to declared majors and the general student body. Students have clearly demonstrated minimal interest in the Court Reporting degree which has resulted in very low graduation rates. Consequently, this has impacted student enrollment and graduation rates (i.e. only one student completed the degree requirements in 2010). Note: The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) has specified that no new enrollments will be admitted after 2013-14.

2. Is this program an “In Demand” occupation?

According to Bureau of Labor Market Statistics, employment of court reporters is expected to grow by 14 percent from 2010 to 2020, as fast as the average for all occupations. Those with experience and training in techniques for helping deaf and hard-of-hearing people, such as real-time captioning and Communication Access Real-Time Translation (CART), will have the best job prospects. Unfortunately, due to low student interest/enrollment, this program not is “InDemand” at MDC. There is an employment trend seeking individuals who hold a bachelor’s degree in field.

3. How many students are currently enrolled in this program?

As illustrated in the following chart, there were 24 declared Court Reporting Technology degree seeking students College-wide for Academic Year(s) 2007-2012. For students declaring this program major, the School of Business has made contact and advised on the policies/procedures governing the Teach-Out process. Note: ONLY six (6) students confirmed their interest in pursuing/finalizing the AS degree in Court Reporting. For more information, see attached Teach-Out Plan.

4. How will you be advising/accommodating students (e.g., Shift to another program, Program Transfer option). Develop a specified period of time for program completion Teach-Out option

All active students have been notified with the use of different means (i.e. email, phone, and certified letter) about the current program status and SACS Teach-Out requirement. In addition, 18 students have met with their academic advisor/chair and have selected to switch into other programs that will improve their probability of employment in the sector (i.e. AS in Computer Information Technology, etc.). Note: ONLY six (6) students (out of 24) confirmed their interest in pursuing/finalizing the AS degree in Court Reporting and have agreed to complete the Teach-Out process.

The School of Business has provided the opportunity for students who wish to complete the program a two year teach-out option. For further information, see the Teach-Out Plan. The program is to sunset in summer 2013-3.

Note: College-wide Office Administration class schedules have been created to facilitate student matriculation for the specified terms, giving students ample opportunity to complete their declared majors within the Teach-Out period. For students who selected to transition into other MDC programs, the School of Business has met with and shifted students appropriately.
