Extended Benefits Program/Corporate Tuition Reduction

Chatham University offers a 20% tuition reduction for employees enrolling at the University and participating in their companies' tuition reimbursement program.

In order to qualify for this benefit, Miami Dade (a) lege (Company) agrees to:

- Communicate this educational opportunity to employees as an employee benefit
- 2. Provide employees in the Company with access to information/materials about Chatham (to be supplied by the University).
- 3. Invite the Chatham Admissions Office to participate in any recruiting events it may host that pertain to educational opportunities for its employees.

Chatham University agrees to assist/counsel employees of Miami Dade College (Company) as to course selection and degree requirements, and to provide support services to such students. This agreement must be completed and submitted prior to the end of each semester's add/drop period to be effective for that term. Students must submit a signed employer-paid tuition form to the College prior to each term they take classes at Chatham. Chatham students who choose to use the Tuition Reduction Benefit Program are not eligible for other reduced tuition rates at the University. This agreement does not extend to students enrolling in the University's Physician Assistant Studies, Occupational Therapy, Doctor of Physical Therapy program, and Doctor of Psychology in Counseling Psychology programs.
