QEP Question: Are students more likely to continuously enroll in math courses?

Answer: Progression to the next course increased for college preparatory courses. Success rates in the subsequent courses varied however, with increases seen for students taking MAT0024 after completing MAT0002 and for students taking MAT1033 after completing MAT0020. For all courses, pass rates for students progressing from the prerequisite courses are below rates for students that test directly into the course.
