This course is designed for students whose writing and/or CLAST essay test scores demonstrate a need for continued instructional support. It also reinforces the principles of composition. Course content is individualized based on specific student needs. This course is repeatable.

Prerequisites: Placement by Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) verbal subtest score; American College Testing (ACT) English subtest score; Computerized Placement Test (CPT) English subtest score or ENC 0021 with a grade of "S."

Course Competencies:

Competency 1 The student will plan and develop essays in response to CLAST-type questions by

- a. Writing an introductory paragraph.
- b. Constructing a thesis statement.
- c. Developing the thesis with specific supporting details.
- d. Writing a concluding paragraph.

Competency 2: The student will proofread, edit, and revise essays by

- a. Recognizing errors and correcting for clarity, unity, and coherence.
- b. Recognizing errors and correcting them according to the conventions of standard edited American English.
