Catalog Description

This course is designed to improve the performance skills, techniques, and knowledge as well as develop competent teaching skills in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation. This course meets the American Heart Association Instructor Certification Requirements for Basic Life Support in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation. This course will also help prepare the student for the competencies necessary for teaching CPR for Healthcare Provider, Heartsaver, Family and Friends and Pediatrics.
