JPN2200 Intermediate Japanese 1

<u>Course Description</u>: Japanese language and culture learned through a systematic review of reading and writing skills with emphasis on oral as well as written presentations. Laboratory activities: Required Prerequisite: JPN1121 or equivalent

Course Competencies:

1. The student will be able to demonstrate listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.

a. Listening - The student will understand spoken Japanese used in both learned and new material by understanding classroom commands and directions given Japanese, understanding oral narratives based on learned material and responding to various types of questions in Japanese, and comprehending native speakers of Japanese.

b. Speaking - The student will respond to material within the limits of the course prescription and will initiate some speaking situations by responding to questions utilizing grammatical principles, initiating conversation, and responding to realistic situations in Japanese.

c. Reading - The student will read and comprehend selected material on a wide range of topics by reading and comprehending selected Japanese readings and responding in a manner which demonstrates comprehension of selected readings.

d. Writing - The student will write compositions based on assigned material, using proper Japanese syntax and grammar by writing responses based on material read and writing compositions employing previously acquired knowledge.

2. The student will apply grammatical principles previously acquired and will increase their knowledge of more advanced grammar by applying previously acquired Japanese grammar in oral and written communication, using previously learned and new Japanese verb tenses, and utilizing more advanced Japanese grammar.

3. The student will demonstrate knowledge and appreciation of the culture of the speakers of Japanese by recognizing attitudes of the speaker of Japanese and illustrating tolerance and acceptance of the culture.
