Miami-Dade Community College OST 2231- COMPUTER AIDED TRANSCRIPTION

<u>Course Description</u>: Computer Aided Transcription (CAT) teaches the students the correct techniques to use and procedures to follow when using computer aided transcription hardware and software similar to most computer courses. Students will be given dictation to be written on a stenotype keyboard. The students will prepare transcripts utilizing a computer aided transcription system where a machine shorthand theory will be input, translated, edited, and output. Students will be evaluated on the number of transcripts completed, the quality of transcripts, and attendance.
