ACG2001L | Principles of Accounting 1 Lab | 3.00 credits

The student will use computer software and financial accounting applications to analyze accounting records and prepare financial statements. The student will learn, with tutorial help and problem- solving, the concepts needed to achieve the objectives of ACG2021.
