



Course Description

ACG2011L | Principles of Accounting 2 Lab | 1.00 credit

Students will use personal computer software and financial accounting applications to analyze accounting records, prepare financial statements, and compile EXCEL spreadsheets. This course will reinforce, with tutorial help and problem-solving, the concepts needed to achieve the objectives of ACG2011. Corequisite: ACG 2011.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will reinforce and apply their knowledge of analyzing and recording financial transactions by entering journal entries on various financial topics in computerize general ledger software

Competency 2: The student will reinforce and apply their knowledge of Receivables by preparing aging schedules in EXCEL
