Course Competency

DEA 0804L Clinical Practice 2

Course Description

This course is a continuation of DEA 0800L. Students will be required to participate and observe clinical and administrative activities in the campus dental clinic and rotate through other community clinics/dental offices where they will get an opportunity to work with a varied patient population as they work on their competence in performing chairside assisting, expanded functions, laboratory, and basic business office procedures.
