

## **Course Description**

### EAP1586 | Advanced 1 - Integrated Reading, Speech & Listening | 6.00 credits

Students will learn to comprehend academic and other authentic reading materials and effectively participate in college-level oral/aural tasks by applying appropriate learning strategies. Prerequisites: EAP 0420 or 0486, and 0400, or equivalent proficiency. Co-requisite: one (1) approved college level course.

# **Course Competencies**

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate understanding of academic materials purposes by:

- 1. Identifying purpose of selections
- 2. Recognizing stated and implied main ideas
- 3. Distinguishing generalizations from supporting information
- 4. Identifying overall organizational and rhetorical patterns
- 5. Expanding academic and general vocabulary
- 6. Identifying the relationship between and within sentences
- 7. Identifying cultural references

#### **Competency 2:** The student will apply critical thinking skills by:

- 1. Asking clarifying questions
- 2. Making inferences and drawing conclusions
- 3. Interpreting writer's point of view and tone
- 4. Distinguishing facts from opinions
- 5. Predicting content from existing background information
- 6. Researching topics and evaluating sources

Competency 3: The student will develop linguistic flexibility and proficiency in reading, speaking and listening by:

- 1. Adjusting strategies to match purpose and task, including interpreting visual data
- 2. Increasing overall reading rate and fluency
- 3. Varying linguistic register to match audience/purpose

#### Competency 4: The student will demonstrate the ability to perform academic oral/aural tasks by:

- 1. Participating in classroom discussions, real and simulated situations
- 2. Following complex instructions
- 3. Using comprehensible pronunciation, stress, and intonation
- 4. Identifying a speaker's main purpose, main ideas and tone
- 5. Taking notes from lectures
- 6. Incorporating cultural references and idiomatic expressions
- 7. Stating and supporting an opinion.
- 8. Expanding and incorporating academic and general vocabulary

## Competency 5: The student will apply appropriate learning strategies needed to accomplish academic tasks by:

- 1. Using the LMS system to complete on-line assignments and activities
- 2. Using self-monitoring and critical reflection to improve language proficiency
- 3. Applying test-taking strategies and skills
- 4. Using EAP-designated labs to support course-related assignments and tests
- 5. Outlining and annotating academic reading materials
