



### **Course Description**

#### **EEC4936C | Student Teaching Seminar II: ECE | 1.00 credit**

The student will learn to discuss and reflect on their development and mastery of the Pre-Professional Florida Educator Accomplished Practices during the completion of their internship in a K-3 classroom setting. Co-requisites: EEC4940C.

### **Course Competencies**

**Competency 1:** The student will recognize the role of the teacher by:

1. Developing short and long term personal and professional goals related to the Florida Educator Accomplished Practices
2. Reflecting on K-3 student learning experiences and outcomes to plan for instruction
3. Identifying instruction that uses a variety of culturally and linguistically relevant materials and resources in K-3 settings
4. Participating in a variety of professional activities appropriate to the area of specialization

**Competency 2:** The student will prepare for professional employment by:

1. Participating in sessions on applying for jobs with Miami-Dade County Public Schools and Broward County Public Schools
2. Participating in a session on the purpose and creation of the Instructional Performance Evaluation and Growth System
3. Preparing a Professional Development Plan with the assistance of cooperating and supervising teachers and reflecting on meeting its goals

1. Identifying graduate school opportunities that are available in the local community
2. Recognizing the importance of educational neuroscience and differentiating instruction in the classroom for diverse learners
