



### **Course Description**

#### **FIL2131 | Screenwriting 2: Character Development & Advanced Story Structure | 3.00 credits**

In this workshop-style intermediate level course students will learn about character development and various story structures for narrative motion picture screenplays. Prerequisite: FIL1100.

### **Course Competencies:**

**Competency 1:** The student will develop characters for screenplays by:

1. Identifying character traits in screenplays
2. Examining character arcs
3. Applying character traits through written assignments

**Competency 2:** The student will understand various forms of story structure by:

1. Identifying story structure paradigms
2. Interpreting the use of story structure paradigms
3. Applying story structure for a screenplay through written assignments

**Competency 3:** The student will develop advanced screenplay format techniques by:

1. Analyzing various screenplay format techniques
2. Examining the use of formatting techniques
3. Applying advanced screenplay format techniques by writing a short-length screenplay
