



Course Description

FIL2553C | Editing Level 2: Intermediate Editing and Visual Effects | 3.00 credits

An intermediate course in which students will learn video editing with an emphasis on sound design and visual effects. Prerequisite: FIL2552C.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will develop and demonstrate an understanding of the aesthetics of editing by:

1. Identifying the components of effective picture and sound editing
2. Comparing and contrasting the cumulative effects of editing in visual storytelling
3. Recognizing visual and audio literacy as it applies to editing

Competency 2: The student will understand and apply image finishing techniques by:

1. Identifying various components for image quality
2. Enhancing the images to meet industry standards and practices
3. Executing enhanced images into a post-production project

Competency 3: The student will understand and apply audio finishing techniques by:

1. Identifying various pre-recorded sound components and formats
2. Implementing a Foley and ADR recording session
3. Utilizing advanced dialogue editing techniques
4. Mixing multiple sound components into a media project
