

Course Description

FIL2553C | Editing Level 2: Intermediate Editing and Visual Effects | 3.00 credits

An intermediate course in which students will learn video editing with an emphasis on sound design and visual effects. Prerequisite: FIL2552C.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will develop and demonstrate an understanding of the aesthetics of editing by:

- 1. Identifying the components of effective picture and sound editing
- 2. Comparing and contrasting the cumulative effects of editing in visual storytelling
- 3. Recognizing visual and audio literacy as it applies to editing

Competency 2: The student will understand and apply image finishing techniques by:

- 1. Identifying various components for image quality
- 2. Enhancing the images to meet industry standards and practices
- 3. Executing enhanced images into a post-production project

Competency 3: The student will understand and apply audio finishing techniques by:

- 1. Identifying various pre-recorded sound components and formats
- 2. Implementing a Foley and ADR recording session
- 3. Utilizing advanced dialogue editing techniques
- 4. Mixing multiple sound components into a media project
