

## **GER 1120 ELEMENTARY GERMAN 1**

Course Description:

In this course, the student will be able to develop socially and culturally appropriate proficiency in interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational modes at the novice midlevel in German. Note: Students must pass this course with a C or better to continue to GER 1121. (4 hr. lecture)
