HIM 0274C HEALTH CARE BILLING AND REIMBURSEMENT

Course Description

This is a foundation course in healthcare reimbursement. Students will learn the reimbursement methods and concepts related to healthcare and prospective payment system including DRGs, APCs and ASC groups, patient billing and accounting software in claims processing, compliance, the role HIM plays in the Chargemaster maintenance and revenue cycle. Prerequisite: HIM 0650. (120 contact hours)

 Examining coding compliance issues that influence reimbursement. Identifying various government statutes, regulations and laws that impact health care reimbursement. 	

Competency 3: The student will demonstrate knowledge of healthcare claim follow-up and payment processing by:	1. Numbers / Data
 Performing patient accounting functions including claims, denials, rejections, appeals, collections, and payment resubmission. Describing the processes and methods used to collect outstanding balances. Describing the procedures for clearing uncollectible balances.
