MSS0215 | History and Standards | 1 credit

This course covers the history and development of massage therapy, basic legal concepts related to health care employment, business practice and legal requirements for practice as a Massage Therapist in the State of Florida.

- d. Describing and avoiding all levels of sexual misconduct.
- e. Explaining and staying within the scope of practice of massage therapy.
