Course Description

This course will provide inter- and intra- professional relationships, and terminology used in the handling of patients, correspondence, legal and ethical principles, office management, and the Laws and rules of Opticianry. You will also develop a modified business plan to open a retail ophthalmic dispensary. You will write a resume and prepare to be interviewed. The basic history of Opticianry, Optometry, and Ophthalmology is also traced.
