

## **Course Description**

## REA0007 | Developmental Reading I | 4.00 credits

REA 0007 is a college preparatory reading course. Students will learn to build vocabulary skills, literal and critical comprehension skills, and successful reading strategies. Lab time required. Prerequisite: Non-demonstration of readiness through placement testing or alternate methods.

## **Course Competencies**

Competency 1: The student will identify the topic and stated/implied main ideas in a paragraph by:

1. Identify specific information in a paragraph

Competency 2: The student will distinguish between major and minor details in a paragraph by:

2. Identifying the purpose between major and minor in a paragraph

**Competency 3:** The student will recognize the tone in a paragraph by:

- 1. Distinguish between fact and opinion in a paragraph
- 2. Identify patterns of organization in a paragraph focusing on time order, listing, comparison and contrast, generalization and definition, and example

Competency 4: The student will Identify transition words associated with the patterns of organization by:

- 1. Recognizing relationships between and within sentences
- 2. Identifying and using context clues to determine the meaning of words in sentences
- 3. Identify logical inferences and conclusions based on evidence provided in a paragraph
- 4. Recognize the point and support of an argument
