



Course Description

RTV1241C | Television Production 1 | 4.00 credits

An introductory overview of the practices and procedures used in a television studio. Students will learn basic operation of studio and control room equipment and work towards the completion of broadcast standard projects.

Course Competencies

Competency 1: The student will demonstrate proficiency in the use of basic television studio equipment by:

1. Identifying the components of camera, microphones, and support equipment
2. Applying settings for camera, microphones, and support equipment
3. Identifying three-point studio lighting
4. Preparing a television studio for a production

Competency 2: The student will demonstrate proficiency in the use of basic control room equipment by:

1. Identifying the components of the video switcher
2. Identifying the operation of a character generator
3. Illustrating the basics of video and audio editing
4. Recording a live studio production

Competency 3: The student will follow industry standard protocol and procedures by:

1. Discussing the fundamentals of television directing
2. Analyzing on-air camera performance
3. Defining crew positions and individual responsibilities for television studio production
4. Integrating crew and talent positions for live television studio production

Competency 4: The student will incorporate various visual components into a television production by:

1. Identifying shot composition
2. Composing dynamic visual images
3. Using a variety of shots
4. Communicating with camera personnel in a television production
