## **Course Description**

Writing, spelling and punctuation, sentence struct ure and reading selections for vocabulary expansion as they are relevant to the training of individu al students. Prerequisite: oral ability to communi cate in Spanish or permission of department chairp erson. (3 hr. lecture)

a. Written accent rules by using these rules to accent Spanish words.
