

SPW 2020 SELECTED READINGS IN LATIN AMERICA LITERATURE

Course Description

SPW 2020 explores Latin-American Spanish literature through reading, discussion and written analysis of poetry, drama, and the novel, focusing on Spanish culture, society, and humanistic expressions through the various genres. The course will be conducted in Spanish. Oral and written fluency in Spanish and/or permission from faculty or Department Chairperson.
