

Course Description

VIC1000 | Visual Communication | 3.00 credits

An introductory course in which students will learn the visual aspects of film, video, photography and graphic arts, specifically dealing with design elements and principles.

Course Competencies:

Competency 1: The student will define the dimensional aspects of a film or graphic design by:

- 1. Identifying the components of light, color, area, time, and motion in a film or graphic design
- 2. Examining films and graphics for their components
- 3. Applying and demonstrating knowledge of the dimensional aspects of film or graphic design through class presentations

Competency 2: The student will comprehend the key elements of visual communication by:

- 1. Examining lighting techniques in black-and-white films
- 2. Examining color theories in film and graphic design
- 3. Examining aspect ratio in a graphic image or a film
- 4. Examining graphic forces and vectors
- 5. Applying vital elements of visual communication in assignments

Competency 3: The student will communicate visually by:

- 1. Developing clear and compelling images that create a desired reaction from the viewer
- 2. Applying clear and compelling images through a class presentation

Learning Outcomes:

- Communicate effectively using listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills
- Demonstrate an appreciation for aesthetics and creative activities
