MDC and the National Science Foundation (NSF) offer three scholarships for Biotechnology

- 1. Advancing Careers in Excellence (ACE) – Contact : Dr. Guillermina Damas, (305) 237- 3658**
 - Offers scholarships with a maximum amount of \$5,000 per academic year
 - Requirements for Eligibility
 - Student must have 3.0 or above GPA
 - Be Eligible for Financial Aid
 - Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, national or alien admitted as a refugee at time of application
 - Be enrolled full time (12 credits per major term)
 - Be exempt or have completed college preparatory courses
 - Participate in an interview with the selection committee.
 - Submit a completed application packet prior to the deadline (August 20 for the Fall term; December 19 for Spring term)

 - Offers scholarships with a maximum amount of \$4,600 per academic year
 - Requirements for Eligibility – Same as ACE

 - Student at either Wolfson or Kendall campus
 - Student must have 2.0 or above GPA
 - Remain in good academic standing throughout their participation in the program
 - Have interest in majoring & transferring to a four year program in science, technology, engineering or mathematics.
 - Be exempt or have completed college preparatory courses at time of application, except MAT1033
 - Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, national or alien admitted as a refugee at time of application
 - Submit a completed application packet prior to the deadline (Fall & Spring term) each academic year.
 - Complete a minimum of nine credits per major term (fall & spring) each academic year.
