



## GUIDE FOR YOUTH VOLUNTEERING

### **About this Guide**

Each week, Hands On Miami receives a multitude of calls and e-mails from students looking for a suitable way to fulfill their community service hours required for graduation. The Youth Volunteer Guide will help do just that! This guide is a detailed list of community service agencies that would like to have student volunteers. Some volunteer opportunities listed are only available during the summer, but most are available year-round. Agencies are listed in alphabetical order. Indexes, which list agencies according to issue area and geographic area, are also included. The volunteer opportunities listed in this guide are not organized or led by Hands On Miami.

Each agency listing includes a contact name, phone number, e-mail address (if applicable), minimum age for volunteers with and without adult supervision, and a brief description of the duties volunteers are needed to perform. Once you have found an agency that suits your needs and interests, simply contact the person listed. All questions regarding the volunteer opportunities should be directed to the contact person listed for that particular agency. If after calling an agency, you find that volunteer opportunity is not for you, try another! It may take a few calls before you find a good match.

### **Documenting Community Service Hours**

Students who need to document community service hours for graduation requirements or other purposes should check with their schools as well as the agencies where they are volunteering to see how this should be done. It may be necessary for the student volunteer to prepare a verification form for the agency to sign.
