It also includes creating safe, meaningful experiences and outdoor activities for individuals to enjoy the environment and our natural resources.

Healthy Communities

Includes volunteer efforts to help the elderly, disabled, diseased, hungry or homeless and to improve the economic health of the community. These could include volunteering for health and nutrition education services, immunization campaigns, resume building, career training, disease screenings, hospital support, blood drives, veterans outreach, working with local public health programs, micro-enterprise, and business development.

Public Safety and Emergency Response

Includes volunteer efforts to help individuals and families make their homes and communities safer from the threats of crime, terrorism, and disasters of all kinds. Includes preparedness training, volunteer firefighters, programs like Citizen Corps, Neighborhood Watch, Medical Reserve Corps, and Volunteers in Police Service.
