

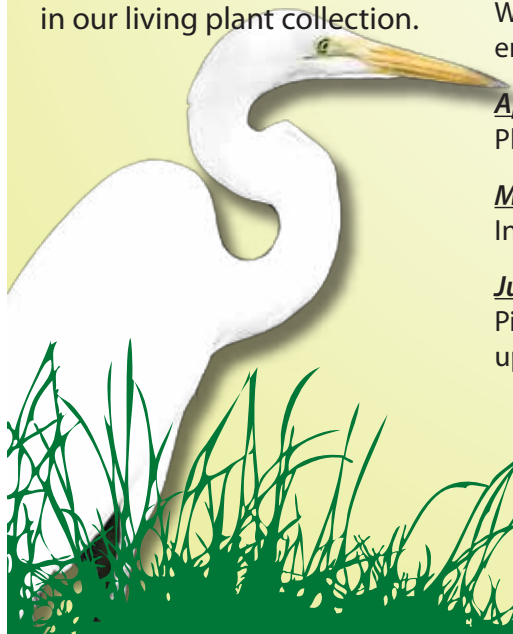
SECOND SATURDAY NATURE DAYS
