 - b) Market (target Market)
 - c) Analysis (size up the completion)
 - d) Management Team (who is on your team, his/her qualifications/duties)
 - e) Business model/operational plan (license, advertising)
 - f) Financial Projections (cash flow)
 - g) Disaster plan (outline the worst case scenario)
 - h) Sources of Income (investors, loan)

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- 1. Candidates must be registered in the College Credit Certificate in Business Entrepreneurship at Miami Dade College Kendall Campus
- 2. Interest in a career in the Financial Industry
- 3. U.S. citizen or permanent residents
- 4. Demonstrated financial need based on federal financial aid standards, as determined by the College's Financial Aid Office.
