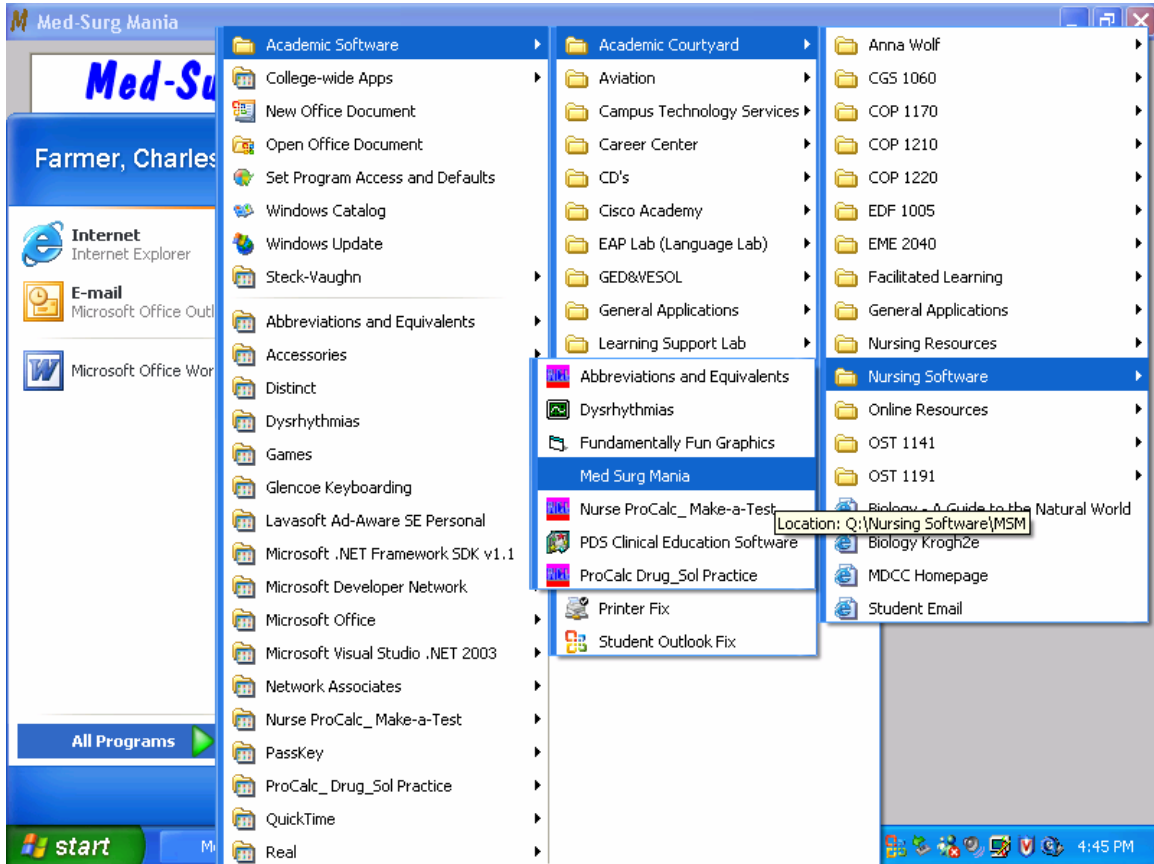

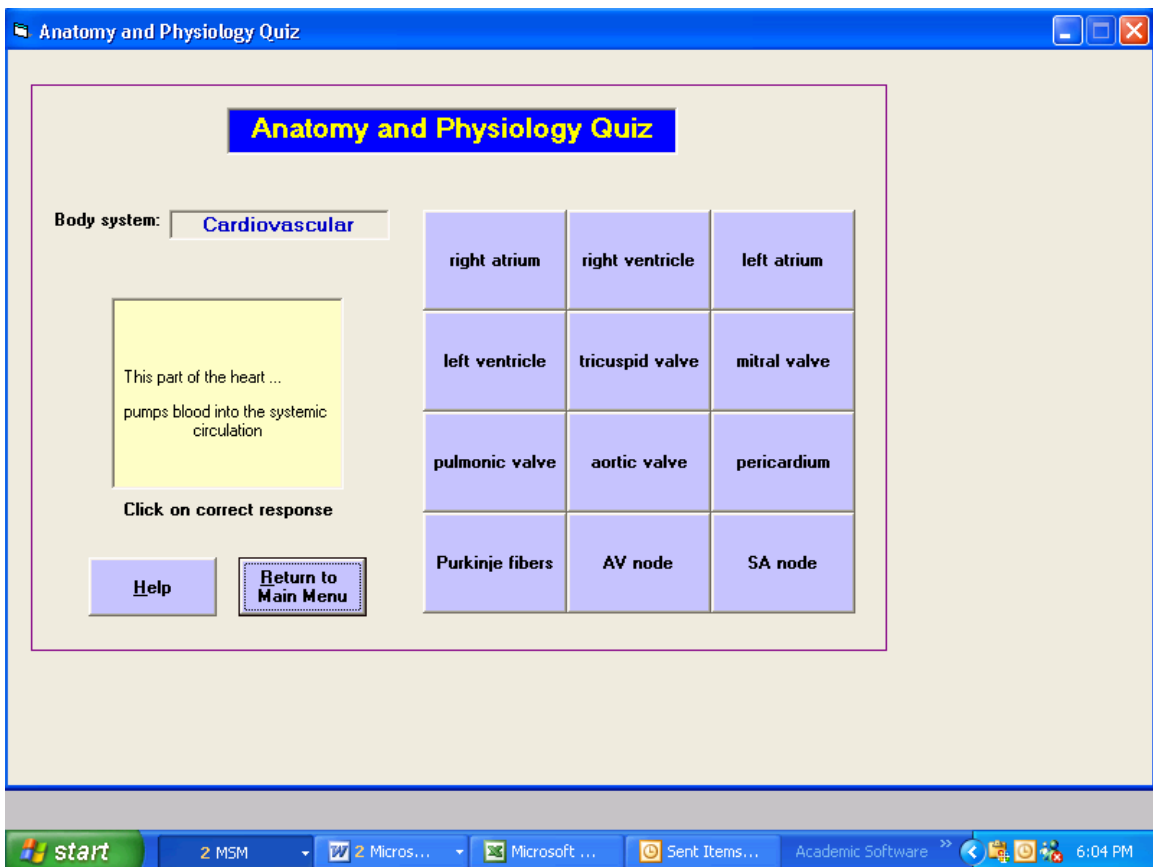

This quiz tests knowledge of anatomy and physiology. Questions appear on the grid on the right. As a question appears, select the box on the grid containing the correct answer.

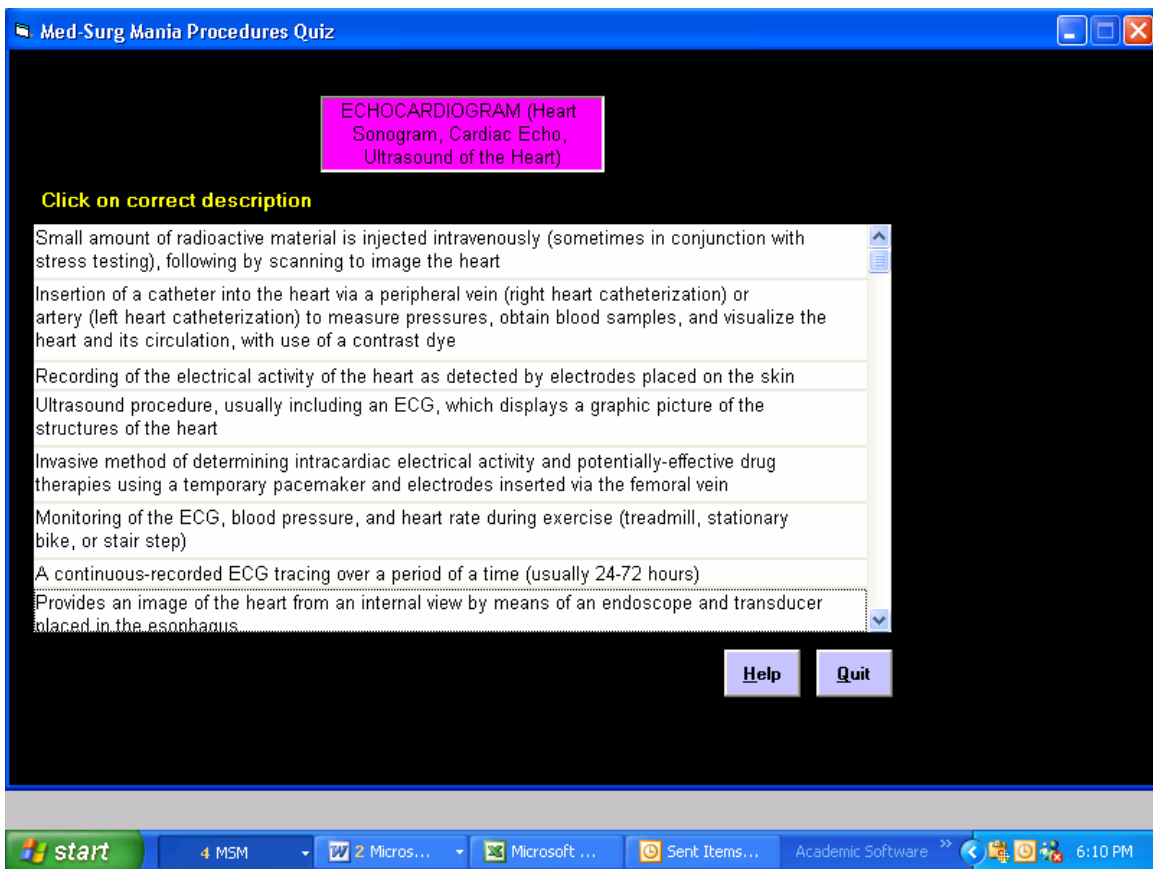
Disorders

disorder, after correctly identifying its description, you will automatically move on to the signs and symptoms quiz for the disorder.

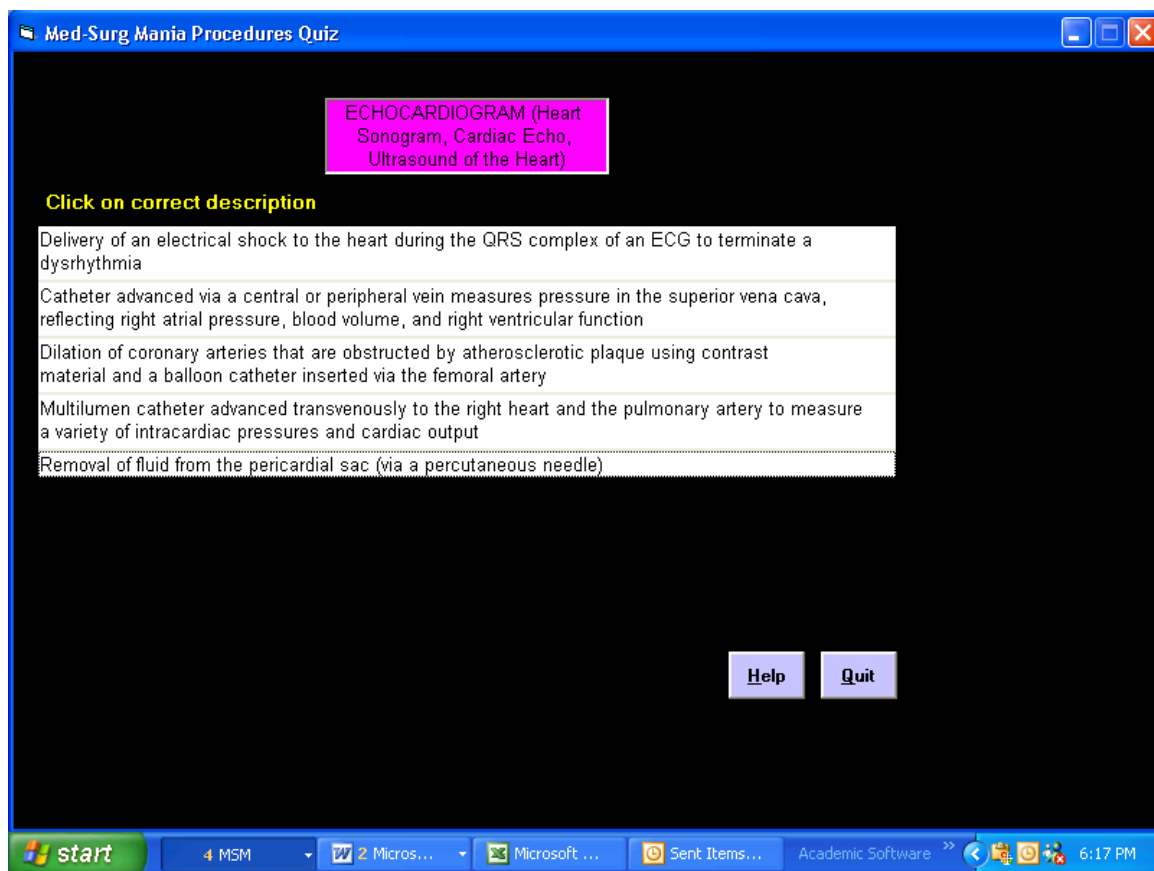
Diagnostic Procedures

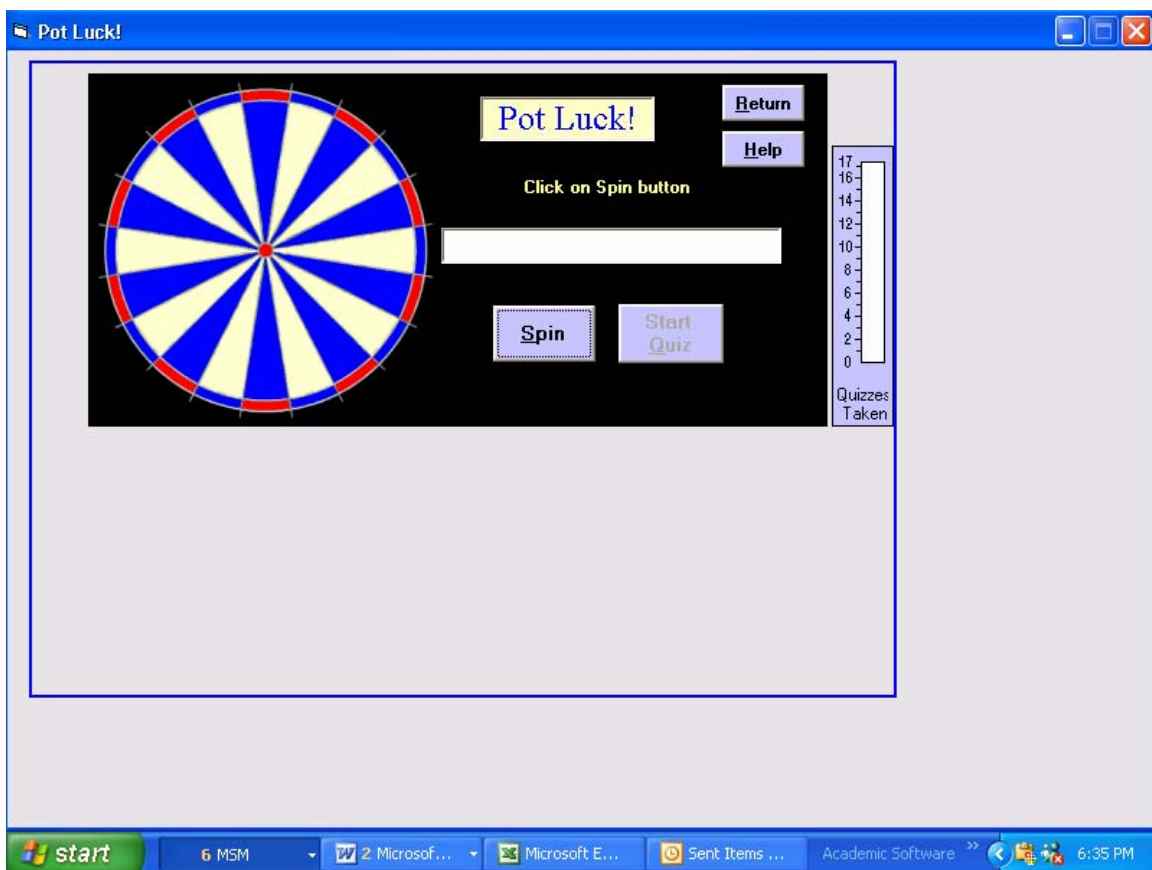
