About the Program...

The Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) in Supervision and Management prepares graduates for leadership roles and positions in a variety of industries. The upper division coursework includes applied management practices; prepares students for supervisory and management opportunities within their technical field; and affords students the opportunity to demonstrate the application of acquired knowledge, skills, and competencies through internship and capstone experiences. After graduation, students will be prepared to advance to supervisory and managerial positions in a wide variety of industries, including financial services, retail, hospitality, marketing, aviation management, food service, insurance, real estate, office administration, and sales.

Admissions Requirements...

To be admitted into the BAS in Supervision & Management program (P9200), applicants must:

- Complete **MDC online credit application**, if you are not currently an MDC student: www.mdc.edu/business
 - Complete **BAS application online**: www.mdc.edu/business
 - Have **earned associate's degree** from regionally accredited institution*
- OR
- Have **completed 60 credits** from regionally accredited institution, with 45 credits applicable to BAS requirements*
- Have a minimum cumulative **GPA of 2.0** or higher
 - Have taken **MAN 2021**, Principles of Management

* Must include ENC1101, ENC1102, and 2 approved college-level math courses in order to be admitted into the BAS program.
