**Student Chooses either Spanish/English Track or Haitian-Creole/English Track**

This program is designed to provide bilingual students with the knowledge and skills necessary to carry out the work associated with areas of translation (written) and interpretation (oral) in the workplace. Graduates are prepared for positions as court interpreters/translators, in-house translators/interpreters for the private sector (including translation/interpretation agencies), translators for government agencies, hospital interpreters/translators, freelance translators/interpreters, and telephone interpreters. Graduates have the beginning foundation to establish their own translation/interpretation business.
