HAI2341: HAITIAN-CREOLE FOR NATIVE SPEAKERS 2

Course Description:

A continuation of HAI2340. Emphasizes fluency in Haitian-Creole grammar and writing. Recommended for translation/interpretation students or native speakers wishing to improve their knowledge of written Haitian-Creole. Conducted entirely in Haitian-Creole.

Prerequisite: Fluency in Haitian-Creole as determined by the Haitian-Creole placement exam or HAI2340.

Course Competencies:

- Competency 1: The student will exhibit increased fluency in Haitian-Creole writing by planning and developing multi-paragraph essays (including analysis, synthesis, evaluation, etc.) using a variety of sentence structures and vocabulary, exhibiting clarity, coherence and substance, and applying standard writing conventions.
- Competency 2: The student will demonstrate the ability to edit written Haitian-Creole work by proofreading and revising writings while attending to grammar, mechanics, clarity, coherence, substance, audience, and purpose.
- Competency 3: The student will demonstrate the ability to cite references by gathering information, integrating information into written work, and using appropriate citations.
- Competency 4: The student will demonstrate the ability to execute other academic Haitian-Creole writing tasks by:
- a. responding to test questions calling for higher order thinking.
 - b. providing written responses to reading selections.
 - c. writing reaction papers (reflection on personal experiences as they relate to academic topics).
