ITA 2200 Intermediate Italian 1

Course Description: Italian culture learned through a systematic review of reading and writing skills with emphasis on oral as well as written presentations.

Laboratory activities: Required

Prerequisite: ITA 1121 or equivalent

Course Competencies:

1. The student will be able to demonstrate listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.

a. Listening. The student will understand spoken Italian used in both learned and new material by

- 1a. understanding classroom commands and directions given Italian.
- 2a. understanding oral narratives based on learned material and responding to various types of questions.
- 3a. comprehending native speakers.

b. Speaking. The student will respond to material within the limits of the course prescription and will initiate some speaking situations by

- 1b. responding to questions utilizing grammatical principles.
- 2b. initiating conversation.
- 3b. responding to realistic situations.

c. Reading. The student will read and comprehend selected material on a wide range of topics by

- 1c. reading and comprehending selected readings.
- 2c. responding in a manner which demonstrates comprehension of selected readings.

d. Writing. The student will write compositions based on assigned material, using proper syntax and grammar by

- 1d. writing responses based on material read.
- 2d. writing compositions employing previously acquired knowledge.

2. The student will apply grammatical principles previously acquired and will increase their knowledge of more advanced grammar by

- a. applying previously acquired grammar in oral and written communication.
- b. using previously learned and new verb tenses.

- c. utilizing more advanced grammar.
3. The student will demonstrate knowledge and appreciation of the culture of the speakers of Italian by
- a. recognizing attitudes of the speaker of Italian.
 - b. illustrating tolerance and acceptance of the culture.
