ITA 2201 Intermediate Italian 2

Course Description: Understanding, speaking, reading, writing and cross-cultural awareness, through systematic review of reading and writing skills with emphasis on oral as well as written presentations.

Laboratory activities: Recommended

Prerequisite: ITA 2200

Course Competencies:

1. The student will demonstrate listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.
 - a. Listening. The student will understand the spoken Italian used in both learned and new material by
 - 1a. understanding oral narratives based on learned material and responding to various types of questions.
 - 2a. comprehending native speakers.
 - b. Speaking. The student will respond to material within the limit of the course prescription and will initiate speaking situations by
 - 1b. responding to questions.
 - 2b. initiating and participating in conversations and discussions.
 - 3b. responding to realistic situations.
 - 4b. delivering prepared and impromptu speeches.
 - c. Reading. The student will read and comprehend selected material on a wide range of topics by
 - 1c. reading and comprehending selected readings.
 - 2c. responding in a manner which demonstrated comprehension of selected readings.
 - d. Writing. The student will write compositions based on assigned materials using proper syntax and grammar by
 - 1d. writing responses based on material read.
 - 2d. writing original compositions.

2. The student will apply their knowledge of more advanced grammar especially through conversation and writing by

- a. applying previously acquired grammar in oral and written communication.
- b. applying the finer distinctions in grammatical structures.

3. The student will expand knowledge and appreciation of the cultural contribution of the speakers of Italian by

- a. explaining the attitudes of the culture of the speakers of Italian.
- b. illustrating tolerance and acceptance of the culture.
