PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The following steps **MUST** be completed by **Friday, April 17, 2015** to be eligible for the program:

1. Complete the enclosed MDC admission application. The Florida Residency Statement section on the reverse side of the admission application must be completed by a parent or guardian. Acceptable documents to qualify as a Florida Resident for tuition purposes are outlined on the Florida Resident for Tuition Affidavit.
2. Complete JumpStart application, essay, and recommendation form.
3. Pay the \$30.00 MDC Admission Application fee at the Bursar's office, Room 1118.
4. Take the *Postsecondary Education Readiness Test* (PERT) in the Testing Department, Room 1110 at the InterAmerican Campus. (If you took the SAT or ACT, have scores sent electronically to MDC.)
5. Complete the 2014-2015 and 2015-2016 Federal Financial Aid Application at www.fasfa.ed.gov
6. If accepted, it is required to attend two Orientation sessions on May 19 and June 12, 2015.
