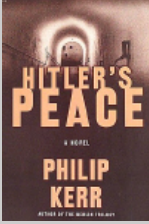

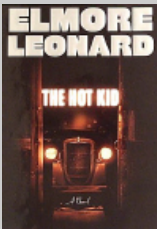
Hitler's Peace: A Novel of the Second World War Kerr, Phillip

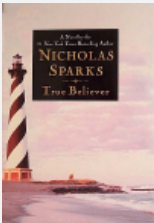
Mermaid Chair Kidd, Sue Monk
