**Placement Guide:** The following placement scores on the CPT are in effect. If scores on one or more of the subtests require college preparatory placement, students must enroll in at least one college preparatory course during their first term. **Students placing into college preparatory course work in one skill area are required to enroll concurrently in SLS 1505; two or more skill areas are required to enroll concurrently in SLS 1535.**
