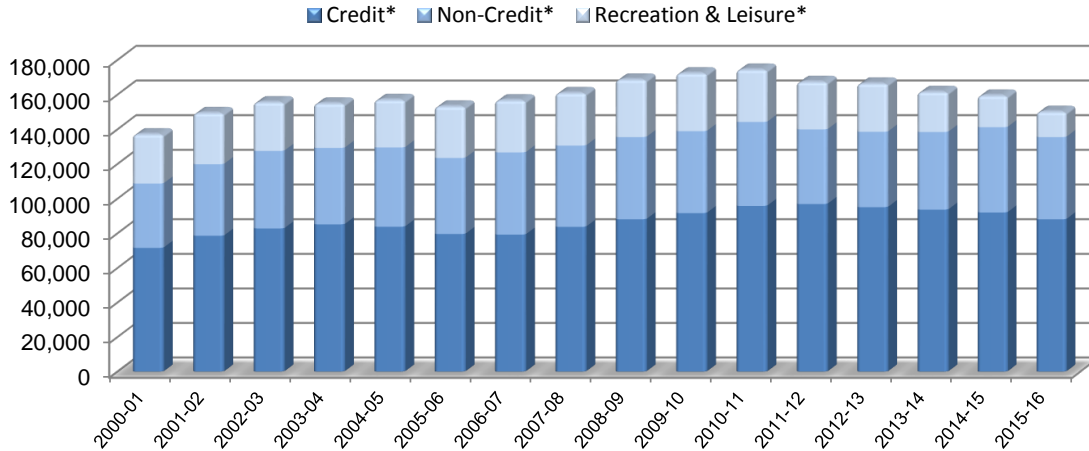


Annual Enrollment Changes in Last Decade
