Padrón heads the nation's largest institution of higher education. As Chief Administrative and Academic Officer he is responsible for the affairs of six campuses and several outreach centers enrolling over 168,000 students. The college has the largest enrollment of Hispanic students and the second largest enrollment of black non-Hispanic students in the U.S. It ranks first nationally in associate's degrees awarded to minorities, and holds the number one ranking for total degrees awarded, and the college has developed the nation's most ambitious bilingual education program. Padrón has spearheaded development of over 60 new degree and short-term programs in response to economic and workforce needs.
