The Gilman Scholarship aims to diversify and expand participation in international study by awarding grants of up to \$5,000 to undergraduate students who have been traditionally **under-represented** in education abroad.

Eligibility Criteria

- U.S. Citizen
- Undergraduate in good standing
- Pell Grant Recipient at the time of application
- Is applying or has been accepted to a university approved, undergraduate credit-eligible program of study abroad
- May study in any country worldwide with the exception of Cuba and those countries currently under a U.S. Department of State Travel Warning
- Program must be a minimum of four weeks

- Statement of Purpose
- Follow-on Service Project
- Academic Progress and Performance
- Diversity of Participant
- Fields of Study
- Country of Destination
- U.S. Institution and State Distribution (Community College Students are encouraged to apply)
- Length of Study
- Preference is given to students with no previous study abroad experience
