1. Open your Web browser and go to: www.dianahacker.com/bedhandbook



2. Click on the "Go to site" link to access the Book Companion Site.

This link appears under the "Free & Open Web Site" section on the left-hand portion of the screen. (See illustration.)

3. Click "Student" to register as a student

The "Student" link is located in the lower right portion of the site under the heading, "I am not registered. Sign me up as a(n):" (See illustration).



4. Complete the simple registration form.

▶ Enter your e-mail address and your first and last name. ▶ Choose a password for yourself that is at least 4 characters long and something you will easily remember (you will need it to access student materials in the future). ▶ Retype your password in the "Verify" field. ▶ In the "Password hint" field, enter a question that will remind you of your password, should you forget it. ▶ Enter your instructor's email address. ▶ When you have finished, click "Submit" to register with the system.





Once you have clicked "Continue," you will be returned to the home page—as a logged-in student. Student resources are available from this page. Click on any of the 8 diamonds to access content.
