DESCRIPTION:

This course of instruction is designed to address the demands placed on an officer regarding the operation of the police vehicle. To safely and efficiently perform this duty-required task, an officer must have a working knowledge of laws dealing with such operation, a knowledge of vehicle capabilities (and limitations) and vehicle dynamics; and a professional attitude consistent with his/her department's policies in the use of the police vehicle.

An officer must develop greater skills than those required of the average driver. He/she must learn to anticipate hazardous movements by other motorists and to employ preventive measures to avoid collisions, even though another driver or drivers are in error in a given situation.

This program is designed to provide police officers with precision driving skills in an effort to reduce injuries to police officers and private citizens, as well as reduce agency operating costs associated with police vehicle crashes.
