Ability-to-Benefit (ATB) Testing Guidelines

Students who did not earn a "standard" high school diploma or GED are required to pass an approved Ability-to-Benefit test to qualify for Federal Financial Aid Programs under the U.S. Department of Education "Ability-To-Benefit" guidelines. As of February 1, 2002 MDC uses the Internet version of the CPT (ACCUPLACER on-line) for this purpose. Additional information is available from the campus Financial Aid Department. The test is not timed but the average test time is 2hours. The sections of the test include Reading, Sentences Skills, and Arithmetic.
