The College President or designee shall establish procedures to address environmental matters as well as the safety, health and sanitation requirements of applicable federal, state and local laws, including State Requirements for Educational Facilities (SREF). These procedures shall serve as the College's program of safety, health and sanitation for the protection of the occupants of College buildings and ancillary plant. The procedures shall also provide for required inspections; the withdrawal of any educational/ancillary plant, or portion thereof, from use until unsafe or unsanitary conditions are corrected or removed; and for a notification process in the event of a casualty.
