I. PURPOSE

To provide for a process for the determination of resident status for tuition purposes or to change residency status.

II. PROCEDURE

- A. Students attending college credit programs or courses must be classified as residents or nonresidents for the purpose of assessing tuition. The [Florida Residency Declaration for Tuition Purposes](#) form must be completed and submitted along with supporting documentation to the office of Admissions and Registration.
- B. Dependent students must have a parent or legal guardian complete the affidavit with supporting documentation.
- C. The effective date of the residency status will be the current term if the student has demonstrated to have been a bona fide resident of Florida on the first day of classes.
- D. Students who have not enrolled at the College for more than one year must re-establish residency for tuition purposes by the methods described above.
