TPP1700 Voice for the Stage 3 credits

The study and application of voice production, breathing, articulation, accents and movement in the actor's delivery. Emphasis is on clarity, precision, properly phrased and meaningful communication from the performer to the audience. (3 hour lecture)

Course Competencies: By the conclusion of the course students should be better able to
Express themselves vocally with greater efficiency than at the start of class
Understand, discuss and develop their vocal processes
Understand the relationship between text, voice production and performance
Utilize the above information in performances

Policies and Procedures

1. Attendance and punctuality
 - a. Punctual attendance is mandated at every class. There are no "permitted" absences. You are permitted one absence without penalty. Each additional absence will result in a reduction to your grade. If you miss more than four classes you will be dropped from the course. If you are late for class one half an absence will be assessed.
