**Note 3:** Credits for Natural Science Lab courses will count towards the General Education Elective and/or the 24 Hour Elective Block.

**Note 4:** Credits earned by taking CGS 1060 are split between the General Education Elective and/or the 24 Hour Elective Block.

**Note 5:** Effective Fall 2014 Foreign Language is an AA degree graduation requirement AND for admission to the baccalaureate. Requirement is 8 credit hours or equivalent. Students can satisfy requirement with proof of proficiency via CLEP or two consecutive years of successful, foreign language completion in high school. A student whose native language is not English is exempt, provided the student demonstrates proficiency in his/her native language. Students who must take foreign language at MDC may take it during any term. However, this may necessitate moving other required courses to a later term(s). Credits earned by taking a Foreign Language course are split between the General Education Elective and/or the 24 Hour Elective Block.

**Attention:** (Gw) satisfies Gordon Rules Writing requirements and (Gc) satisfies Gordon Rules Computation requirements.
