**ART1300C | Drawing | 3.00 – 4.00 credits**

Basic problems in freehand drawing, including perspective, still-life and landscape. Emphasis is on developing a sense of structure through line, form and texture.

2. Analyzing shapes as plane and volume
3. Creating abstract versus figurative patterns
4. Examining proportions
