## CJE3110 | Law Enforcement Systems | 3.00 credits.

An analysis of the different law enforcement systems in Criminal Justice. Focuses on the different law agencies and their mission at the local, state, and federal levels.

### **Course Competencies:**

# Competency 2: The student will explore law enforcement by:

- 1. Identifying the numerous local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies
- 2. Identifying the basic requirements for becoming a police officer
- 3. Discussing the recruitment of minority groups and women
- 4. Analyzing the structure of the police department

# Competency 3: The student will demonstrate knowledge of law enforcement responsibilities by:

- 1. Defining the role of law enforcement
- 2. Describing the role of law enforcement in providing services
- 3. Analyzing the role of law enforcement in preventing crime
- 4. Identifying the role of law enforcement in preserving the peace

## **Competency 4:** The student will analyze the use of discretion in police systems by:

- 1. Defining discretion
- 2. Understanding discretionary powers
- 3. Identifying the elements that influence discretion
- 4. Citing current trends and recommendations regarding discretion

### Competency 5: The student will demonstrate knowledge of local law enforcement jurisdictions by:

- 1. Citing and describing the functions and responsibilities of various agencies at the local level
- 2. Analyzing the jurisdiction of the local agencies
- 3. Identifying the limitations imposed by law at the local levels
- 4. Exploring current trends and special programs

#### **Competency 6:** The student will demonstrate knowledge of state police and highway patrol organizations by:

- 1. Citing and describing the functions and responsibilities of the various agencies at the state level
- 2. Comparing and contrasting the mission statement of the state agencies
- 3. Identifying the limitations imposed by law on the state agencies
- 4. Exploring current trends and special programs

Competency 7: The student will identify and discuss the various functions and responsibilities of federal law

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#### enforcement agencies by:

- 1. Citing and describing the agencies that make up the federal system
- 2. Analyzing the reorganization of these agencies due to homeland security concerns
- 3. Recognizing the evolving mission of the federal agencies
- 4. Exploring current trends and special programs

## **Competency 8:** The student will demonstrate knowledge of private security agencies by:

- 1. Citing and describing the types of agencies that comprise the private security sector
- 2. Analyzing how private security interacts with public agencies
- 3. Recognizing the limitations as imposed by law
- 4. Exploring current trends and particular problems

**Competency 9:** The student will demonstrate knowledge of the internal organization of law enforcement agencies by:

- 1. Comparing and contrasting the chains of command and their impact on organizational structures and efficiency
- 2. Analyzing specialized units and their missions and functions
- 3. Debating succession plans
- 4. Listing and describing unions for law enforcement and the collective bargaining process and its impact on law enforcement

**Competency 10**: The student will demonstrate knowledge of government and law enforcement working together by:

- 1. Comparing and contrasting the advantages and disadvantages of elected versus appointed officials
- 2. Identifying the roles of law enforcement in the local government hierarchy
- 3. Analyzing the interrelationship between law enforcement and the political structure
- 4. Analyzing the interrelationship between law enforcement and the political structure
- 5. Identifying the impact of budgets on law enforcement organizations
